Courses to Build Statistical Capacity

The Centre for Indigenous Statistics and Partnerships' Indigenous Statistical Capacity Development Initiative enables Indigenous organizations and communities to develop and sustain their own statistical capacity by providing training on various topics as they relate to statistics. Currently, courses are only available in English, with French courses forthcoming.

The following courses are offered online lead by an instructor virtually:

- Preparing Funding Proposals
- Surveys from Start to Finish
- Introduction to Excel
